## PREFACE.

We take pleasure in presenting to the public the LAKESIDE DIRECTORY for 1892 in its new form. The Chicago Directory, in consequence of Chicago's growth, has increased to such a size that we found it impossible to keep it within the covers in the old shape. We therefore have changed the Directory to the present form, enlarging the page considerably, and making it a three column book instead of two. We trust it will meet with the approbation of our patrons and the public in general, and be found more convenient and readily handled.

The size of the book will indicate somewhat Chicago's increase in the past year. It is now the largest City Directory published in the United States, having nearly one-fourth more matter in it than that of the New York City Directory. It is twice the size of the Chicago Directory published ten years ago, and three times the size of the one published twenty years ago.

We regret to say that the confusion arising from the duplicating of street names and numbers, occasioned by the annexing of the outlying towns two years ago, has not been entirely overcome, some of them not having yet been changed. They are, however, being put through the Council slowly, and we trust by the time the World's Fair visitors reach us that this slight inconvenience will be fully rectified. We still use the marks, "L.", "H. P.", "L. V.", "J.", etc., after addresses in Town of Lake, Hyde Park, Lake View, and Jefferson, where duplication would cause confusion.

Chicago's growth during the past year in population has been as marked as heretofore, and taking the ordinary means of computation, Chicago at present contains 1,420,000 people. This we believe to be a very conservative estimate. Our growth has not only been in population, but also in business. The changes this year have been more pronounced than in any previous year in the existence of Chicago. The many gigantic business buildings which have gone up within the year causing thousands of changes. There has also been a tendency of manufacturing plants that have heretofore been in the outskirts of the South Side business districts, to move to the West Side or to the outlying manufacturing towns.

With each Directory this season we will issue a subscriber's card, which will give subscribers the privilege of referring to our Directory Library, which contains the Directories of other large cities. These cards will be numbered in duplicate with the book delivered to our subscribers, and a complete register of such books and numbers will be kept at our office in order to assist us to trace up stolen books, Directory Thieves and Borrowers having occasioned hundreds of our subscribers considerable annoyance and loss in the past.

For convenience of our patrons we keep a compiled list of new names and changes which may be referred to when name sought can not be found in present edition.

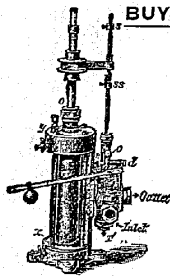

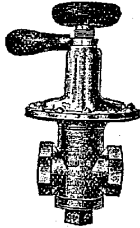

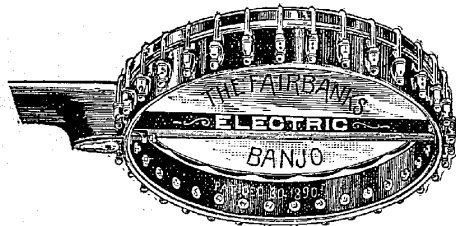

# STREET AND AVENUE GUIDE.

**EXPLANATORY.**  
 The City comprises Seven Divisions, known as the North, South and West Divisions, Hyde Park, Lake, Calumet, Lake View and Jefferson. Streets that cross the Chicago River have the prefix N. North of the River, and W. West of the River, but the prefix E. or S. is (with two or three exceptions) never used. Thus, the correct names are Erie and W. Erie, Lake and W. Lake, Clark and N. Clark, State and N. State, etc. In the West Division, all streets that cross W. Randolph have the prefix N. or S. Thus, N. Ada, North of Randolph, and S. Ada, South of Randolph, West of Union Park (where W. Randolph ends) W. Lake street is the dividing line. On any street, the relative location of a house is given by running down the column of figures, which are its numbers at the several crossings of the streets that intersect it. The right hand number after crossing is usually given. For example, to find 44 State, it will be seen that 30 is on the corner of Lake, and 66 is on the corner of Randolph; hence 44 is between these two streets. Where no numbers are given, the corners and often the blocks, are vacant. Streets running from the Lake west, through the Towns of Hyde Park and Lake have duplicate numbers, viz., fr. the Lake to State, and fr. State to West City Limits.
