## MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

**FOREST PRESERVE DISTRICT OF COOK COUNTY Commissioners**  
The commissioners of Cook county by virtue of their office also serve as commissioners of the forest preserve district of Cook county authorized by an act of the legislature approved June 27, 1913, and adopted by a referendum on August 12, 1913.

## Forest Preserve Property

The forest preserve district of Cook county on Sept. 1, 1920, held title to approximately 1,000 acres in the district. Some details as to the various preserves follow:

## STATE DEPARTMENTS

**AGRICULTURE** (Division of Agriculture and Dairies), 303 S. Dearborn av. R. 1416. Superintendent—Alfred H. Jones.  
**AGRICULTURE** (Division of Cattle and Fish), 298 S. Wabash av. R. 1101.  
**AGRICULTURE** (Division of Animal Industry), 357½ S. W. Exchange Blvd.

**AGRICULTURE** (Division of Forest Grove Preserve), 1,150 acres of hilly woodland land, some groves and fenced for deer; twenty-five acres of land which has developed into a home for deer. Coway's Elk Grove Preserve—1,000 acres of woodland land, has big ponds and bird refuges.

Des Plaines River Valley Preserve—Seventy-five acres of land, some groves of Indian paint and some groves of reception given Father Marquette, the pottawatamie Indians here, the white man's first visit to Cook county, 1773 N. W. Dearborn av. 1000 ft. from the town of Des Plaines to Higgins road, containing tracts of natural prairie and sites of a few dozen Indian villages.

North Branch Chicago River Valley Preserve—Contains 1,000 acres of oak and maple forest. Glen, Turnbull, Badek and Glen View tracts; Indian reservation contains 1,000 acres of oak and maple forest. Billy Caldwell, the old Indian chief; his tract contains old Turnbull homesite and Indian village of Cook county's pioneers in Indian days; Bush's tract, another favorite Indian haunt.

Thatcher Park Preserve—Contains also Steele Park; preserve consists of hundreds of acres of oak and maple forest.

Salt Creek Valley Preserve—On both banks of Salt Creek, 1,000 acres of Prairies river to the west county line; picturesque river valley with splendid views.

**CHICAGO ZOOLOGICAL GARDENS**  
Dec. 1913—Mr. Harold F. McCormick purchased to Cook a tract of 300 acres of land, valued at about \$300,000 and lying on the west bank of the Chicago River, just above the city, as a site for a large zoological garden. The plan committee met on Dec. 31 and voted unanimously to accept the gift, and it was agreed that the name of McCormick should be named the "McCormick Zoological Garden." Mrs. McCormick, her dead son, still situated there, who should be the "Chicago Zoo," was substituted for "Gardens."

The Chicago Zoological society, which will be the park, was incorporated in February 1921.
